Progress of Working Group III towards the IPCC Fifth Assessment Report

Overview

IPCC-XXXIX/Doc.13 presented to and agreed to by the 39th Session of the IPCC (IPCC-39) described progress in Working Group III's (WGIII) contribution to the Fifth Assessment Report (AR5). This document provides an update since IPCC-39, and highlights major achievements and planned activities through the end of September 2014. Specifically, the status of WGIII AR5 report en route to publication, errata, conflict of interest policy-implementation, synthesis report contribution, and outreach activities are discussed. Finally, the remaining milestones are mapped out.

1. Summary

Recent key activities have been:

- Approval of the WGIII AR5 Summary for Policymakers, acceptance of the entire underlying scientific assessment.¹
- Extensive outreach to increase knowledge of WGIII key findings in target audiences.
- Finalization of IPCC Conflict of Interest policy implementation.
- Going live with WGIII AR5 report Website www.mitigation2014.org
- Publication of the final draft and the approved Summary for Policymakers online.
- Participation in the Synthesis Report (SYR) Core Writing Team Meetings CWT-3bis and CWT-4.

2. WGIII AR5 Writing Process

2.1 Preparation for Publication

Following IPCC-39/WGIII-12, the approved Final Draft of the WGIII contribution to AR5 was published online at www.mitigation2014.org on April 15, 2014 ². The SPM alone has been downloaded 34,700 times (5.1.1 for more detail). WGIII has also made available the First and Second Order Drafts as well as the errata, as required by IPCC regulation. Responding to requests, the Technical Support Unit (TSU) has also published high definition versions of figures used in the final draft (http://mitigation2014.org/report/figures).

The Final Draft, which has been accepted at IPCC-39, counts 2092 pages, 713 of which are dedicated to listing the references underlying the comprehensive assessment of WGIII. The report is currently being prepared for publication and a professional desktop-publisher is typesetting the book in close cooperation with WGIII TSU. The TSU is also coordinating with the publisher, Cambridge University Press, as well as preparing the distribution of the report to decision makers. Publication is expected in November 2014.

2.2 Contribution to Synthesis Report

WGIII is actively involved in the development of the AR5 Synthesis Report. The SYR core writing team includes ten authors, the three WGIII Co-Chairs and two member of the WGIII TSU. The extended writing team includes another nine members of WGIII. One WGIII author and one WGIII Bureau member are serving as Review Editors. WGIII representatives took part in the SYR CWT-3-bis meeting, (which followed the IPCC-39 in Berlin) as well as the CWT-4 in Malaysia, 30 June - 3 July, Putrajaya, Malaysia.

Together with representatives from WGI and WGII, WGIII representatives are currently preparing the final draft of the SYR, which will be released to governments 25 August 2014. WGIII members of the core writing team will also attend the CWT-5 meeting and the SYR Plenary approval session in October in Copenhagen, Denmark.

3. Status Conflict of Interest

The WGIII Technical Support Unit (TSU) has completed the last renewal round of the IPCC formal Conflict of Interest (COI) policy during AR5 cycle. Six people reported activities and/or roles that might have constituted basis for the COI but following a thorough analysis of their cases by WGIII Bureau it was determined that no COI existed in any of the cases. The COI report of the IPCC WG III was submitted to the IPCC Secretariat at the end of February 2014 and on 6 May 2014 IPCC Secretariat confirmed completion of WG III COI policy process.

4. Summary for Policymakers Errata

In the Summary for Policymakers (SPM) of the Working Group III (WGIII) Contribution to the IPCC Fifth Assessment Report, Climate Change 2014: Mitigation of Climate Change, an initial set of errors was identified by the authors of the report after approval and acceptance at the 12th Session of Working Group III and the 39th Session of the IPCC in Berlin, April 2014. Designated IPCC Focal Points and Ministries of Foreign Affairs (MFAs) were informed about this set of errors on 2 May 2014. Consistent with the Error Protocol, the erratum was dealt with through the rapid response process and approved by the IPCC Executive Committee on 12 May 2014. The corrected SPM was subsequently distributed at the UNFCCC Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) meeting of 4 -15 June 2014, and other important events.

For the Working Group III contribution to the IPCC Fifth Assessment Report other potential errors procedures were launched in line with Section 2 of the Error Protocol subsequently. The WGIII Co-Chairs as well as the Coordinating Leading Authors (CLAs) of the relevant chapters of the underlying report evaluated the errors. Then the WGIII Co-Chairs and relevant CLAs constructed errata statements for the Summary for Policymakers and submitted them to the WGIII Bureau for approval. Following WGIII Bureau approval, the Secretariat wrote on September 15, 2014 to the National Focal Points seeking agreement for the Panel to delegate the approval of the proposed errata to the Executive Committee. No objection was raised by the established deadline of September 22, 2014 and the Rapid Response procedure was launched. On September 23 an objection was received from one country and the Executive Committee stopped the Rapid Response procedure and decided to defer the decision on the errata to the next 40th session of the Panel.

5. Outreach

For communication and outreach on WGIII AR5, the WGIII Co-Chairs and TSU have implemented the IPCC Communication Strategy and have carried out activities as planned in consultation with the WGIII Bureau and the IPCC Secretary and Senior Communication Manager. This includes the development of communications materials, a dedicated website and setting up outreach events.

5.1 Communications materials

5.1.1 Report website

The WGIII SPM, TS, chapters and annexes were published on the IPCC and WGIII AR5 websites on April 13th. In coordination with Working Groups I and II, WGIII has developed a microsite dedicated to WGIII AR5. www.mitigation2014.org that was launched online in March 2014. Before approval of the AR5 SPM, the Website featured video interviews with IPCC and WGIII representatives, background materials, and announced the release.

Following the approval of WGIII AR5, the Website has been updated to feature audio and visual files for journalists and further press materials. The Website has been developed in close coordination with the other IPCC Working Groups to ensure full consistency and a common layout.

During the first four months of operation, the AR5 microsite has been visited by more than 61,500 people from 210 countries, totaling to more than 540,000 page views. After the initial peak in the visitors and report downloads, the website usage has now stabilized to around 1,600 weekly users serving more than 14,500 page views each week.

The report file downloads are estimations due to the chosen web architecture. During the first four months, the total download estimation is more than 119,000. Summary for Policymakers has the largest share of 34,700 downloads, followed by the Technical Summary (9,200). The total number of final draft chapter downloads is estimated to be around 70,000 – of which the three most downloaded chapters are: Chapter 1 (5,840), Chapter 11 (5,820) and Chapter 7 (5,700).

The AR5 microsite is continuously updated and remains the main communication channel of the report and outreach events. Working Group III is also collaborating with the IPCC secretariat to publish new functionalities in the near future, namely a user friendly search tool to comments and consideration of comments of governments and expert reviewers.

5.1.2 Video documentary

Work on the WGIII video documentary was completed in time for it to be launched at an IPCC WGIII special event during the SBSTA meeting in Bonn. Guidance and input has been provided to Snöball, the Norwegian film producers hired by IPCC Secretariat. Extensive filming and author interviews took place during the WGIII preparatory meeting. This third part of the IPCC AR5 video documentary has been viewed more than 20,000 times to date. Youtube views alone strand at roughly 15,000 views.

5.1.3 Print products

For the purposes of outreach at COP-19, a special brochure containing the WGIII AR5 Summary for Policymakers was produced.

As was done for previous reports, a Summary Volume containing the Summary for Policymakers, Technical Summary, Frequently Asked Questions and Glossary of the WGIII AR5 is being produced. It will be translated into the UN languages and printed copies will be available from the IPCC Secretariat.

5.2 Post-plenary press conferences & WGIII AR5 launch events

5.2.1 Press conferences

At the IPCC press conference on 13 April 2014, Working Group III Co-Chairs Ottmar Edenhofer, Ramón Pichs-Madruga and Youba Sokona presented the Summary for Policymakers in Berlin. Panellists included IPCC Chair Rajendra K. Pachauri and the Deputy Secretary of the IPCC, Gaetano Leone. Authors that have contributed to the report were present. The IPCC Senior Communication Manger Jonathan Lynn moderated the press conference.

The Summary for Policymakers, press release and other materials were posted online at the start of the press conference. The press conference was webcast via the IPCC main site.

Following the IPCC press conference, Ottmar Edenhofer was panelist for a press conference organized by the German government with State Secretary Jochen Flasbarth of the German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Building and Nuclear Safety.

5.2.2 Interviews

Following launch WGIII Co-Chairs, Bureau members, and present authors did interviews with media present in Berlin, by phone, and satellite transmissions to broadcasters worldwide. Authors in their home countries also did interviews.

Focusing on international news agencies, WGIII Co-Chairs did a number of interviews under embargo, which were released following the publication of the report and press release.

5.2.3 Public Launch of WGIII contribution to AR5 at the Technical University Berlin

The public launch of the WGIII Contribution to AR5 took place at the Technical University Berlin. The event was attended by 1200 guests and 100 media representatives. Co-Chair Ottmar Edenhofer presented the WGIII contribution to AR5. The German Federal Minister for Economic Affairs and Energy Sigmar Gabriel, IPCC Chair Rajendra Pachauri and WGII Co-Chair Chris Field spoke at the occasion. Video of the documentation is available on demand at the website of the TU Berlin.
