

Antonina Ivanova is a Professor and Senior Researcher at the Autonomous University of Baja California Sur, Director of the APEC Studies Centre of the State of Southern Baja California and Secretary of the Mexican Consortium of APEC Studies Centres. Her research interests are oriented to the interface between international trade, sustainable development, security and environment. She is First Degree Member of Mexico's System of National Researchers with over 100 publications in these areas.
