GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

PASSPORT AND VISA ARRANGEMENTS

Everyone travelling to Nepal must present a valid and approved travel document as evidence of their identity and nationality.

Visas or any documents necessary for travel are the participant's responsibility, and should be obtained prior to departure. Participants should check with the Embassy of Nepal in their country to confirm visa requirements and are responsible for any fees or other costs related to their visa procurement.

INSURANCE

Participants are encouraged to make arrangements for health and travel insurance coverage, if so desired.

TRANSPORTATION FROM THE AIRPORT

For international participants whose accommodation is being arranged by ICIMOD, ICIMOD will coordinate with the respective hotels to arrange airport pickups and will provide buses to and from conference events when necessary. For your return journey, transport from the hotel to the airport will also be provided. You are requested to check with your hotel about the time of departure.

Nepali participants and international participants handling their own accommodation in Kathmandu will need to make their own transportation arrangements.
