OUTREACH EVENT ON THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL PANEL ON CLIMATE CHANGE(IPCC) ROLE, ACTIVITIES AND FINDINGS The University of Fiji, Lautoka, Fiji

This outreach event will take place on 6 October in Lautoka, Fiji. It is kindly hosted by the University of Fiji, supported by Fiji Meteorological Service and with the participation of Bureau members and authors of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC). It will draw on the presence of IPCC experts at the first Lead Author Meeting for the Special Report on the Ocean and Cryosphere in a Changing Climate, taking place in Nadi on 2-6 October.

This event will not only look at the question of oceans and climate change but also will present the most recent findings of the IPCC from the Fifth Assessment Report relevant to Fiji and the future activities of the Panel from 2017 to 2022. Topics will include progress on the Special Report on Global Warming of 1.5°C and the Special Report on the Ocean and Cryosphere in a Changing Climate and the approved outlines for the Sixth Assessment Report. The event will also contribute to The University of Fiji's monthly COP 23 awareness seminar sessions.
