HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Transfers to Wembley Conference Centre will be provided at specified times from all of the hotels apart from the Wembley Plaza (which is adjacent to the Centre). All hotels are approximately 40 minutes from London Heathrow Airport. All travel times shown are for taxi journeys.

By rail: From central London main line stations take the underground to Wembley Park (Jubilee and Metropolitan Lines) or Wembley Central (Bakerloo Line). The hotel is a 10-minute walk from both stations. Follow signs for the Wembley Conference Centre.

From the airport: From Heathrow, take the underground on the Piccadilly Line and change at Green Park station for the Jubilee Line to Wembley Park station and follow the directions as above.

From the airport: From Heathrow, take the underground on the Piccadilly Line and change at Earls Court station for the District Line to Notting Hill Gate station where you should change onto the Central Line to Hanger Lane and follow the directions as above.

From Gatwick Airport, take the Gatwick Express to Victoria station and then take the Victoria Line train to Oxford Circus and the Central Line to Hanger Lane station and follow the directions as above.

By rail: From central London main line stations take the underground to Ealing Common which is on the Piccadilly and District Lines. When you come out of the station cross the road at the pedestrian crossing and turn left, the hotel is 200 metres away. Alternatively you can take the Central Line to Ealing Broadway station and the hotel is approximately one mile away.

From the airport: From Heathrow, take the underground on the Piccadilly Line and change at Acton Town station for either the Piccadilly or District Line train to Ealing Common station and follow the directions as above.

From Gatwick Airport, take the Gatwick Express to Victoria station and then take the District Line train to Ealing Common and follow the directions as above.

By rail: The nearest station is Watford Junction which is accessible from central London via Euston Station. Trains depart every 20-30 minutes. Guests should then pick up a taxi to the hotel (approximate cost: £6)

From the airport: From Heathrow either via train to Paddington in central London and then District Line to Kings Cross and Northern Line to Euston and follow directions as above.

Or pre-book a taxi from United Taxi Hire (telephone: +44 (0) 1923 252525, facsimile +44 (0) 1923 247768). Price will be approximately £30 from Terminals 1, 2 & 3 at Heathrow or £35 from Terminal 4.

From Gatwick Airport take the Gatwick Express to Victoria and the Victoria Line direct to Euston Station and follow directions as above.

Directions to Wembley Park Conference Centre

From Heathrow Airport

Option 1

Take the Heathrow Express train to Paddington Station. Trains run every 15 minutes, and the journey time is 15 minutes. The cost of a ticket is £12.00. At Paddington, purchase a London Underground ticket to Wembley Park (£2.70). Take the Circle Line or Hammersmith & City Line to Baker Street, change to the Metropolitan Line for Wembley Park.

Option 2

Heathrow has two stations on London Underground's Piccadilly Line, one station for Terminals 1, 2 & 3 and one for Terminal 4. Purchase a ticket to Wembley Park (£3.60). Take the London Underground (Picadilly Line) to Green Park. The average journey time is approximately 50-60 minutes. At Green Park, change to the Jubilee Line for Wembley Park.

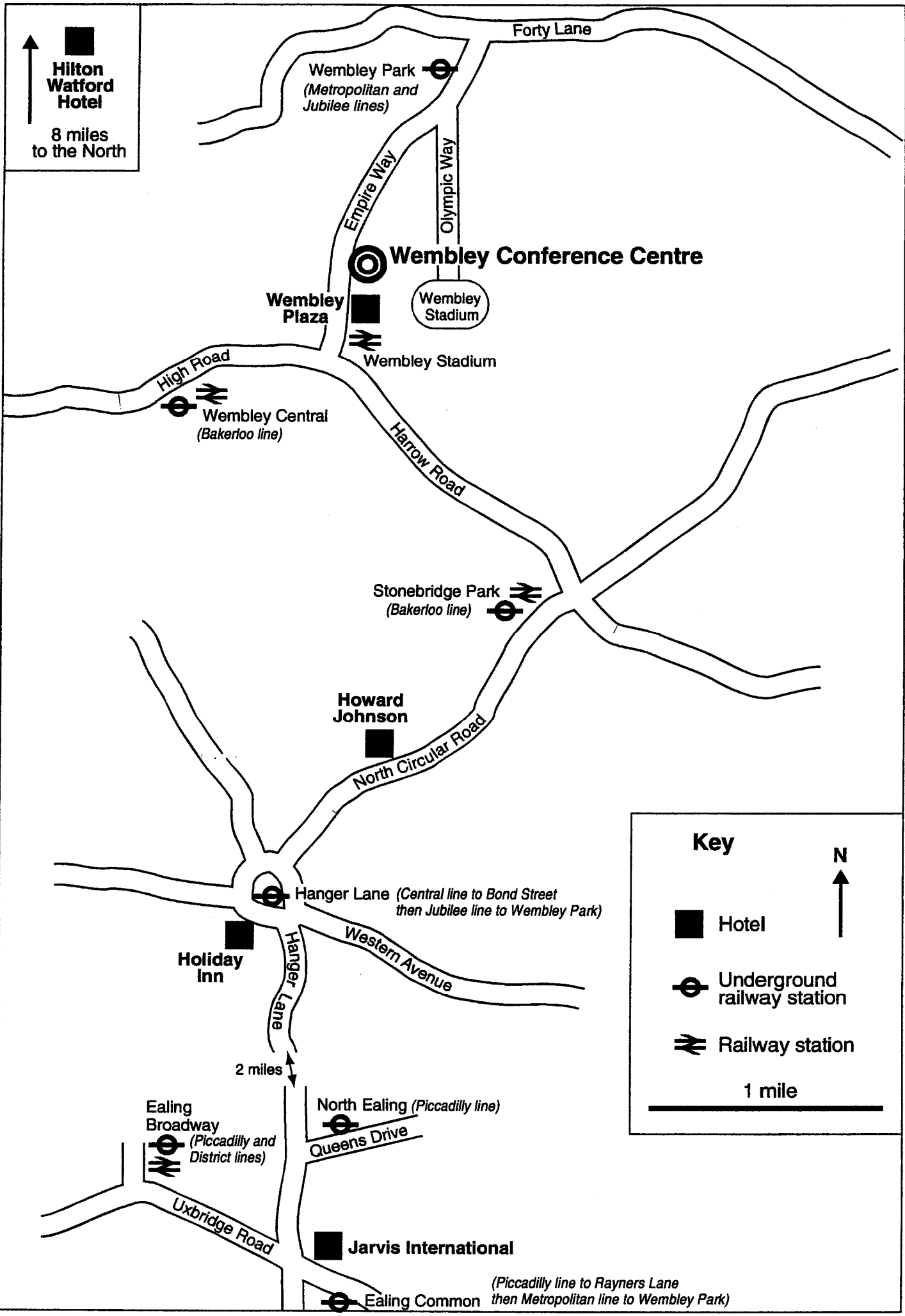
From Gatwick Airport

Take the Gatwick Express train to Victoria Station (ask the ticket teller which platform to go to). Journey time is around 30 minutes. At Victoria, purchase a London Underground ticket to Wembley Park (£2.70). Take the Victoria Line to Green Park. At Green Park, change to the Jubilee Line for Wembley Park.

From Luton Airport

Take the free bus shuttle to Luton Airport Parkway. Purchase a rail ticket to Kings Cross Thameslink. Take the train to Kings Cross Thameslink (journey time 35 minutes). At Kings Cross make your way to the London Underground and purchase a ticket to Wembley Park. Take the Metropolitan Line to Wembley Park OR take the Circle Line or Hammersmith & City Line to Baker Street, change to the Metropolitan Line for Wembley Park.
