## INFORMATION ON WMO IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION

For the 2004-2005 biennium, WMO finances the position of Secretary of IPCC at D-2 level and makes financial contributions of CHF 316,300 (maximum amount) to IPCC. In addition, WMO administers the IPCC Trust Fund in accordance with the WMO Financial Regulations, and provides the IPCC Secretariat (located in the WMO premises in Geneva) with office accommodation, financial services (budgeting, accounting, financial reporting, payroll, payment and cash management), travel services (travel arrangements including processing travel requests, the liaison function with the Travel Agency, in particular with regard to the issuance of flight tickets), information systems support, human resources management services, and general services regarding the use of the WMO facilities infrastructure.

However, the costs that WMO has to incur in providing these services are not charged to the IPCC Trust Fund in accordance with the memorandum of agreement concluded between WMO and UNEP in 1989, while they are estimated at approximately 1.6 million for the biennium 2004-2005.
