IPCC TRUST FUND PROGRAMME AND BUDGET

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Reference is made to document IPCC-XXXII/Doc.3 and the draft report of the 32nd Session of the IPCC which contain information about past expenditures and the decision by IPCC-32 on programme and budget. The budget presented in this document relates to the IPCC Trust Fund only. It should be noted that there are other resources available to the IPCC, notably support services provided by WMO and UNEP, including the provision of the two senior posts in the IPCC Secretariat, generous contributions by the Governments of Germany, Japan, Switzerland and the United States of America which are supporting Technical Support Units (TSUs), support from all those Governments and Organisations which host IPCC meetings and make experts available to the IPCC and voluntary "in-kind" contributions from the Governments of Germany, the United Kingdom and the United States of America to support the operation of the IPCC Data Distribution Centre. In accordance with the decision taken by IPCC-32 a list of in-kind contributions/activities is attached as **Appendix 1**. Information on IPCC compliance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS) regarding external audits is contained in **Addendum 1**.
- 2. This budget document contains two parts. Part A presents the status of income and expenditure for the Trust Fund as of 31 December 2010. Part B includes revisions to the budget for 2011 which had been approved by IPCC-32, a revised proposed 2012 budget, an updated forecast budget for the year 2013 and updated indicative budgets for years 2014 and 2015. Part B includes also a note on possible additional needs.

PART A - INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

- 3. The status of income and expenditures of the IPCC Trust Fund as of 31 December 2010 will be provided in an Addendum to this document once WMO year-end closure is completed.
- 4. **Table 1** provides an update as of 31 December 2010 of the annual rate of voluntary cash contributions to the IPCC Trust Fund since its inception. **Table 2** represents the monthly breakdown of contributions received in 2010 and shows the total contributions received as of 31 December 2010 in the amount of CHF 7,333,339.

PART B: DRAFT BUDGETS

- 5. The budget proposals for the coming years are using the same standard costs as were used for the preparation of the forecast budget for the year 2012 and the indicative budget for the years 2013 and 2014 noted at the 32nd Session. Consideration of any necessary adjustments to standard costs can only be made after a detailed analysis of part A.
- 6. **Table 3** contains a revised budget for the year 2011 taking into consideration the following:
 - Subject to a decision by the Panel to do a methodology report on wetlands guidance provision for a lead authors meeting
 - Removal of provision for the SYR Technical Support Unit
 - Adjustment of number of DC/EIT journeys to correspond to the number of authors selected for the three Working Group contributions to the AR5.
- 7. **Table 4** contains the budget for 2012 proposed for adoption. Major changes to the budget noted by IPCC-32 include:
 - Addition of 2 lead authors meetings on Wetlands Guidance, subject to decision by the Panel

- Adjustment of number of DC/EIT journeys to match the number of authors selected for the
 three Working Group contributions to the AR5 and provisions for a Working Group III expert
 meeting to support, consistent with paragraph 4.2.4.1 of Appendix A to the Principles
 Governing IPCC Work, the review of the 1st order draft of the AR5 (detailed proposal will be
 submitted to Panel Session).
- Reduction in the number of TGICA meetings and a decrease in the number of journeys.
- TFI: the three expert meetings noted as contingency by IPCC-32 translate to one expert
 meeting on 2006 Guidelines related issues, one expert meeting on AFOLU accounting
 issues and contingency for one expert meeting to respond to further requests from the
 UNFCCC.
- Provisions for the SYR TSU of CHF 130,000 to be provided to the IPCC Chair in the same manner as support for developing country Co-chairs.
- 8. The forecast budget for 2013 is contained in **Table 5**. Changes as compared to the forecast budget noted at the 32nd Session include adjustments of numbers of authors and changes related to the SYR TSU. Subject to approval by the Panel of a methodology report on wetlands guidance a lead authors meeting, an IPCC Session to approve the report, including preparatory meetings and publication costs was added.
- 9. The indicative budget proposal for the year 2014 is contained in **Table 6**. The same changes as mentioned in paragraph 8 apply.
- 10. The indicative budget proposal for the year 2015 contained in **Table 7** includes provisions for Secretariat and ongoing IPCC work, a Session of the IPCC, TFI activities and contingency for expert meetings.

Possible Additional Needs

11. Possible additional needs including for the IPCC Secretariat and communication activities are subject to further consideration by the Panel of the recommendations resulting from the review of IPCC processes and procedures carried out by the InterAcademy Council.
