## PROPOSAL FOR ADMISSION OF OBSERVER ORGANIZATIONS

(Submitted by the Secretariat)

## **Proposal for Admitting Observer Organizations For consideration by the Panel at its 26<sup>th</sup> Session**

The Panel adopted at its 25<sup>th</sup> Session in April 2006 the IPCC Policy and Process for Admitting Observer Organizations (Hereinafter, "the Policy and Process"). Paragraph 11 of the Process requires that "admission of observer organizations be included as a regular agenda item of Sessions of the IPCC Bureau and the Panel at the discretion of the Chair."

It is the first time that the Panel will consider acceptance of observer organizations. There were 56 organizations on the mailing list of IPCC Secretariat before the Panel adopted the Policy and Process, and there are 13 new applications afterwards. For those organisations that were on the IPCC mailing list and participated in IPCC Sessions in the past, the Secretariat has asked for information and confirmation of their continued interest to be an observer to Sessions of the IPCC and its Working Groups. The first letter was sent in late October 2005, as requested by the Panel at its 24<sup>th</sup> Session. A second letter was sent in early December 2006 according to the Policy and Process. In addition, the Secretariat received information from the new applicants. Based on the above information and in line with the Policy and Process, the Secretariat screened the status of all these organizations and prepared a proposal for consideration by the IPCC Bureau. The Bureau at its 36<sup>th</sup> Session on 14-15 March 2007 reviewed the proposal. The revised proposal, taking into account the comments of the IPCC Bureau, is now presented to the Panel for consideration.

This proposal contains four Tables, which list organizations that require different levels of attention of the Panel. **Table 1** is a list of 24 UN bodies and organizations and is for information only. In accordance with paragraph 4 of the Policy, the UN bodies and organizations are "considered participating organizations of the IPCC and are not requested to submit an application or other documentation."

**Table 2** presents a list of 28 organizations that the Panel may wish to consider and accept at this Session. The list includes 6 Intergovernmental Organizations (IGOs), and 19 Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) including 3 international programmes that are sponsored by the International Council for Science (ICSU). These 25 organizations were on the mailing list of the IPCC Secretariat before the Panel adopted the Policy and Process. Afterwards the Secretariat received 3 new applications from NGOs that were found qualified for consideration. All IGOs and NGOs in this list have made their requests to become an observer of the IPCC consistent with the Policy and Process. All but two are UNFCCC observers. The two NGOs that are not observers of UNEP, WMO or UNFCCC, have proven their qualification in matters covered by the IPCC by providing supporting documents as required by paragraph 1 of the Process. Therefore, all the IGOs and NGOs on this list are in full compliance with the Policy and Process and can be recommended for acceptance by the Panel.

**Table 3** is for information only. It presents a list of 8 non-response organizations. These organizations have been on the IPCC mailing list, but have not responded to the letters sent by the Secretariat in October 2005 and December 2006, requesting confirmation of their continued interest in the IPCC and its Working Group Sessions. According to paragraph 3 of the Process and suggestions from the Bureau, the Secretariat will contact them further to confirm whether they wish to continue to participate in IPCC and its Working Group Sessions, and report back to the Panel at its next session.

**Table 4** is for information only. It presents a list of 9 organizations, of which 7 organizations are new applicants and 2 organizations have shown their interests. They did not meet the requirement of paragraph 2 of the Process, which requests submission of applications at least 4 months before the  $26^{\text{th}}$  Session of the Panel. The Secretariat will communicate with these organizations further in order to identify whether they are qualified in line with the Policy, and help them meet the respective conditions set in the Process. Qualified applications will be brought to the Panel for consideration at its next session.

The Panel is invited to accept the organizations listed in Table 2 as IPCC observer organizations.
