# IPCC Outreach Programme Progress report and future plans

# 1. Press events at the launch of reports and response to other press requests

The press events at the launch of the three working groups reports attracted unprecedented attention and lead to wide coverage of the reports. Following the launch of the Working Group 2 report a number of regional briefings were organized which were highly appreciated and lead to a number of follow up requests for events and in-depth briefings.

In addition to press contacts at the occasion of the launch of reports the Secretariat also received a large number of requests for interviews and other media activities. They were passed on to the IPCC Chair and other Bureau members, TSUs or authors as agreed in advance with them.

## 2. Presentations and speeches

Appendix 1 provides an overview of events where IPCC presentations were organized by the Secretariat and/or TSUs. During 2007 most of the activities where user driven. The IPCC Secretariat and the TSUs tried to meet the numerous requests for presentations. Special attention and priority were given to events organized by UN bodies and other relevant international organizations. Major briefings were organized for the UNEP Governing Council, the WMO Congress, the UNFCCC Subsidiary Bodies meetings in Bonn in May and the UNFCCC Vienna Climate Change talks in August and the high level event at the UN General Assembly.

In selecting presenters consideration was given to the topic and geographical location, with the aim to minimize travel costs and time, while on the other hand respecting the request from organizers for an international representation. Normally the organizer was asked to cover travel support. In the case of international organizations, which could not provide such support, or IPCC organized briefings, travel support was provided to experts from developing countries. However, in some cases the country of developed country experts was not able to provide support for participation in outreach activities. In such exceptional cases Trust Fund support was provided to the speaker to ensure a balanced programme. In this context countries are kindly requested to facilitate the participation of their experts in outreach activities. The Panel is further requested to allow the Secretary some flexibility in providing funds for developed country experts that are willing to give presentations on the AR4.

There are still a number of requests for in-depth briefings from countries and regional and international organizations. The Secretariat plans to respond to such requests in a broader strategic way, with the aim to systematically cover widely regions and relevant actors. The Secretariat will continue to work with the TSUs and enhance partnership with other UN organizations.

## 3. Publication and translation

The IPCC Secretariat made a lot of effort to speed up the translation of the summary volumes of the Working Group contributions. However, in some cases delays occurred due to a delay in finalization of the volume by the TSU, or unsatisfactory translation work. The translations of the Working Group 1 and 2 summary volumes were in print at the time this document was written. The translations of the summary volume of Working Group 3 are currently being edited and revised.

The full volume of Working Group 1 has been sent to all IPCC Focal Points, as well as to UNEP, WMO and UNFCCC Focal Points who are not IPCC Focal Points. This way of distributing the volumes was considered more efficient then sending hundreds of copies to Bali. As soon as the translations are printed, several copies in the respective language will be distributed in the same manner. Depending on the availability of full volume and translations, a combined or separate distribution of translations and full report will be arranged for the Working Group 2 and 3 volumes. In a second round of initial distribution

summary volumes will be sent to UN depository libraries and relevant organizations. Focal points and Bureau members are encouraged to bring to the Secretariat's attention organizations and entities which should receive such volumes. Focal Points are also invited to order a larger number of copies of summary volumes for distribution in the country.

Files for the working group reports have been posted on the IPCC website as soon as they became available. Also translations into UN and non-UN languages are being posted on the website (new version see below). A more user-friendly way of posting the files, with an efficient search engine, is planned for the upcoming year.

#### 4. Website restructuring

The IPCC website has undergone restructuring and redesigning. It was also moved to a platform which allows easier content management. Works have been carried out by a Geneva based company, based on a call for proposals. The new site should go online in November, in time for the 27<sup>th</sup> Session of the Panel, but some fine-tuning and the application of the new template by the TSU sites will have to be done in the coming months. In particular a powerful search engine needs to be applied.

In restructuring, the site key elements of the old site were maintained, while aiming for a simplified structure. Feedback is welcome to enable us to improve the site and meet user needs better.

#### 5. Animated graphics and other outreach material

So far original figures from AR4 Working Group reports or their SPM/TS are provided on the IPCC website as ppt or jpg file. Presentations given at major events are provided as pdf files only.

In 2008 it is planned to provide some animation for suitable graphics. In cooperation with TGICA the presentation of animated models will be explored.

For the high level event organized by the UN Secretary-General Mr Ban Ki-Moon in New York National Geographic prepared a short video. The IPCC provided advice to National Geographic on the selection of topics, and helped with quality control with regards to references made to the IPCC. In the upcoming year partner organizations, in particular from the UN system should be encouraged to develop further outreach products, including videos or education material.

#### 6. Outreach budget

The budget allocated for the year 2007 for outreach has been fully used and we expect by the end of the year a slight over expenditure. A breakdown on the use of the funds is given in document IPCC-XXVII/Doc. 4, table 3. In order to continue with an active outreach program that meets user demands, it is suggested to increase the budget for the year 2008. A progress report on the use of funds and planned activities will be presented to the Panel at its 28th Session.

#### WG 2 - AR4 Outreach activities in Latin America

#### Latin America

The chosen day, 10 April 2007, as was done in other parts of the world, the CLAs and LAs involved in the development of this report, presented the conclusion in Mexico City and Buenos Aires. Simultaneously, colleagues from Brazil developed a similar action in Rio de Janeiro. From then on a number of events took place in the whole region. Regarding Mexico and Central America, an outreaching event was convened.
