The credentials shall be signed by, or on behalf of, an appropriate government authority of the Member of the IPCC and shall be regarded as appropriate credentials for the participation of the individuals named therein in all activities of the Session. In addition, to facilitate pre-registration and visa arrangements, each participant is kindly requested to complete the attached registration form.

Limited financial support is available from the IPCC Trust Fund to representatives from the developing countries and countries with economies in transition, one per country. Nominations for financial support should reach me no later than **31 August 2010**. I request that this deadline be strictly adhered to because of the time required for the logistics of delivering the support.

Simultaneous interpretation in the official UN languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish) will be provided during the session. All documentation will be in English only. Copies of the following documents are attached to this letter:
