Allow me to recall that the IPCC at its 37<sup>th</sup> Session (Batumi, Georgia, 14-18 October 2013) decided to set up a Task Group on the future work of the IPCC. The objective of the Task Group is to help the IPCC to continue to improve its operations and products. The Task Group will develop options and recommendations for consideration by the Panel during the period leading up to the 41<sup>st</sup> Session of the IPCC in 2015.

As decided by the Panel, the Task Group will draw on inputs from multiple sources, including IPCC observer organizations. Since your organization has observer status in the IPCC it is my pleasure to invite your organization, on behalf of the Co-chairs of the Task Group, to submit its views on the future work of the IPCC using the attached questionnaire form (Annex 1), which reflects the three objectives as agreed by the Panel at its 37<sup>th</sup> Session.
