## Facility for Broadcasters and Interviews - IPCC Synthesis Report

GENEVA, 17 October - Following the press conference at 11.00 on Sunday 2 November 2014 in Copenhagen to present the *Synthesis Report* of the Fifth Assessment Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), IPCC officials and Synthesis Report authors will be available for broadcast interview.

At the press conference, the Chairman of the IPCC, Rajendra K. Pachauri, will present the report. Other panelists will include United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon, the Secretary-General of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), Michel Jarraud, and the Secretary of the IPCC, Renate Christ. Authors that have contributed to the report will also be present.

The list of IPCC experts available for interview can be found <u>here</u>. Please note that interviews themselves must be arranged with the IPCC, using this <u>form</u>.

Please note that only interviews arranged via this process will be considered as confirmed. Any arrangements made directly with IPCC experts may be subject to cancelation.

Broadcasters not attending the press conference can use the services of Liveshot Productions (<a href="http://www.liveshot.de/">http://www.liveshot.de/</a>) for play-out and live broadcasts at the Tivoli Congress Center.

Liveshot Productions will be operational at the location of the IPCC meeting. They will offer the following:
