**Climate Change 2001: Mitigation** 

Accra, 5 March 2001 – More than 140 delegates from 85 governments met in Accra, Ghana from 28 February–3 March 2001 to consider the Working Group III contribution to the Third Assessment Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) "Climate Change 2001: Mitigation".

The full report, which runs approximately 800 pages, represents nearly three years of work by almost 400 authors from around the world. The report went through extensive review by more than 400 governmental and non-governmental experts. In line with the IPCC Principles and Procedures, after four full days of discussion, the delegates unanimously approved the Summary for Policymakers of the report and accepted the full report.
