The <i>Wetlands Supplement</i> provides guidance on estimating emissions and removals on lands with drained and rewetted organic soils in Chapters 2, 3 and 4 and general issues on wetlands are addressed in Chapters 1 and 7."
Chapter 2, Section 2.2.6.2	1457		After "...and algorithms are improving", add a footnote: "For example, to obtain such information, the intergovernmental Group on Earth Observations (GEO) is working with government agencies to acquire and make freely available and accessible, relevant data and related products from remote sensing and <i>in-situ</i> platforms for various countries, including those subject to this supplement and, more broadly, all countries in their reporting under the UNFCCC."
