## Sir/Madam,

I am writing on behalf of the Chairman of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) to advise that Thirty-fifth Session of the IPCC is scheduled to take place in Geneva, Switzerland, on 6-9 June 2012. The venue will be either the Centre International de Conférences Genève (CICG) or WMO headquarter. The decision will be communicated to you in due course.

The Thirty-fifth Session of the IPCC is scheduled to begin at 10:00 hours on Wednesday, 6 June 2012. The focus of this meeting will be on: a) outcome of the IPCC scoping meeting held regarding the review of and possible update of, inter alia, chapter 4 of the Good Practice Guidance for Land Use, Land Use Change and Forestry; b) Review of IPCC processes and procedures; c) Approval of the IPCC Communications Strategy.

Simultaneous interpretation in the official UN languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish) will be provided during the plenary meetings. All documentation will be in English only. Copies of the following documents are attached to this letter:

In addition, to facilitate pre-registration, each participant is kindly requested to complete the attached registration form. Nominations for financial support should reach me no later than **2 May 2012**. I request that this deadline be strictly adhered to because of the time required for the logistics of delivering the support.
