Provisional Programme

This side event is organized on the initiative of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) and will focus on the role and activities of the Panel, its work programme and its relevance to policy and decision making in the context of the implementation of the Paris Agreement and the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda. Valuable information will be provided about the Sixth Assessment Cycle during which the IPCC will be delivering one or more policy-relevant reports every year from 2018 to 2022, except for 2020.

The event will raise awareness about the process of development of the IPCC assessments and how Governments and the world scientific community work together to deliver some of the most widely-researched and authoritative scientific reports. It will explore how Governments and the scientific community could support the IPCC with intellectual capital by encouraging scientists to participate in its work and through the voluntary financial contributions on which it depends.
