The CWT will be established after the Plenary, in agreement with the Bureau.

Next meeting of the ExCom

The Secretariat will determine the date of the next meeting. The ExCom noted that it was more urgent to hold a meeting of the AR6 SYR Scientific Steering Committee (SSC) and the Chair noted that he will reflect on whether to hold an SSC meeting or an ExCom meeting first.

The ExCom discussed the date and venue of the next Bureau session, including the possibility for having a virtual Bureau session. The IPCC Secretary noted that the secretariat would revert with information as soon as possible.
