# 1. Working Group I contribution to the AR6

#### ExCom-75

 Expert and Government Review of the Second Order Draft, deadline extended by up to a maximum of 2 months (the deadline was extended to 5 June 2020 instead of 26 April 2020).

#### ExCom-79

- Literature acceptance cut off date Postponed from 30 September 2020 to 31 January 2021.
- Working Group I Fourth Lead Author Meeting (LAM-4) Postponed from 1 to 5 June 2020 to the week of the 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

# ExCom-87 and Member countries (Letter 5104-21/IPCC/AR6)

- Final Government Distribution (FGD) review postponed to 3 May to 20 June 2021 instead of 7 December 2020 to 31 January 2021.
- A one-week reduction in length of the FGD review starting the review on 3 May instead of 26 April 2021.
- Approval Plenary Session postponed to 26 to 30<sup>1</sup> July 2021 instead of 12 to 18 April 2021<sup>2</sup>.

## ExCom-84

First Core Writing Team (CWT-1), postponed from 7 to 13 December 2020<sup>7</sup> to the week of the 25 to 31 January 20218.

- The Synthesis Report Government and Expert Review postponed from 12 July to 5 September 2021 to 10 January to 20 March 20229.
- As a result of the delay to the Synthesis Report Government and Expert Review, CWT-3 would be delayed from 29 November to 5 December 2021 to 4 to 8 April
- The commencement of the Final Government Distribution and Government review of the SPM would be delayed from 14 February to 17 April 2022 to 13 June to 7 August 2022.
- CWT-4 will take place from 19 to 23 September 2022 followed immediately by the Synthesis Report Approval Plenary from 26 September to 30 September 2022 as per the venue availability in the host country.
