Box 2300, 7bis Avenue de la Paix, CH-1211 Geneva 2, Switzerland, or attached to an email message addressed to <u>ipcc-sec@wmo.int</u>. **Nominations should be made on official letterhead**; as nominations by simple e-mail will not be accepted.

Please pre-register each designated participant, no later than **Monday 17 July 2023**, at the following website: <u>https://apps.ipcc.ch/register</u>, using the unique credentials sent to all focal points in advance of the previous session. Please inform the Secretariat if there have been changes to the name of the focal point.

Pre-registered participants will be required to also register at the conference venue, at which point they will receive access to the IPCC PaperSmart system containing the session documents in electronic format. Documents will not be distributed on paper. Participants are therefore encouraged to bring their own devices to the meeting in order to access the PaperSmart system.
